

## Core - Safety Pass Alliance (SPA)

### Course Overview (Benefits)

This course enables contract personnel to satisfy the need for high standards in Health & Safety training in the food & drink industry. The Food & Drink Safety Passport Scheme, accredited by the SPA is a way of only accepting personnel who hold this Safety Passport. Successful completion of the course results in delegates being issued with an identification passport, which is valid for 3 years. This course meets the statutory requirements of the Health & Safety Executive. The course aim is to:

- Reduce time spent on the induction of contractors on site
- Provides assurance on levels of contractor health & safety awareness
- Ensure all contractors are working to best practice
- Improve job prospects and increase competitiveness through the use of certified personnel

### Course Content (topics covered)

The course program includes:

- Induction to Health & Safety law and safe systems at work
- Workplace safety
- Accidents and first aid procedures
- Fire precautions and procedures
- Hazardous substances
- Manual Handling
- Noise
- Multiple choice examination

We also offer the refresher course to renew the passport after 3 years.

### Course Duration

1 day.

### Target Group

This course is target to contractor personnel working on site.

### Assessment and Certification

At the end of each module throughout the course, delegates will complete short multiple-choice assessments. Upon successful completion, delegates will be awarded with a Safety Pass Alliance card.

### Location of the training

Training will take place at our Head Office in Birkenhead or with prior arrangement at your site.

### Method of Delivery

Classroom based.

### **Course Requirements**

Candidates need to have a basic understanding of the English language. Attendees must bring with them their National Insurance Number. If candidates require any special learning support please speak to the tutor on arrival.
